# Objectives of the Project

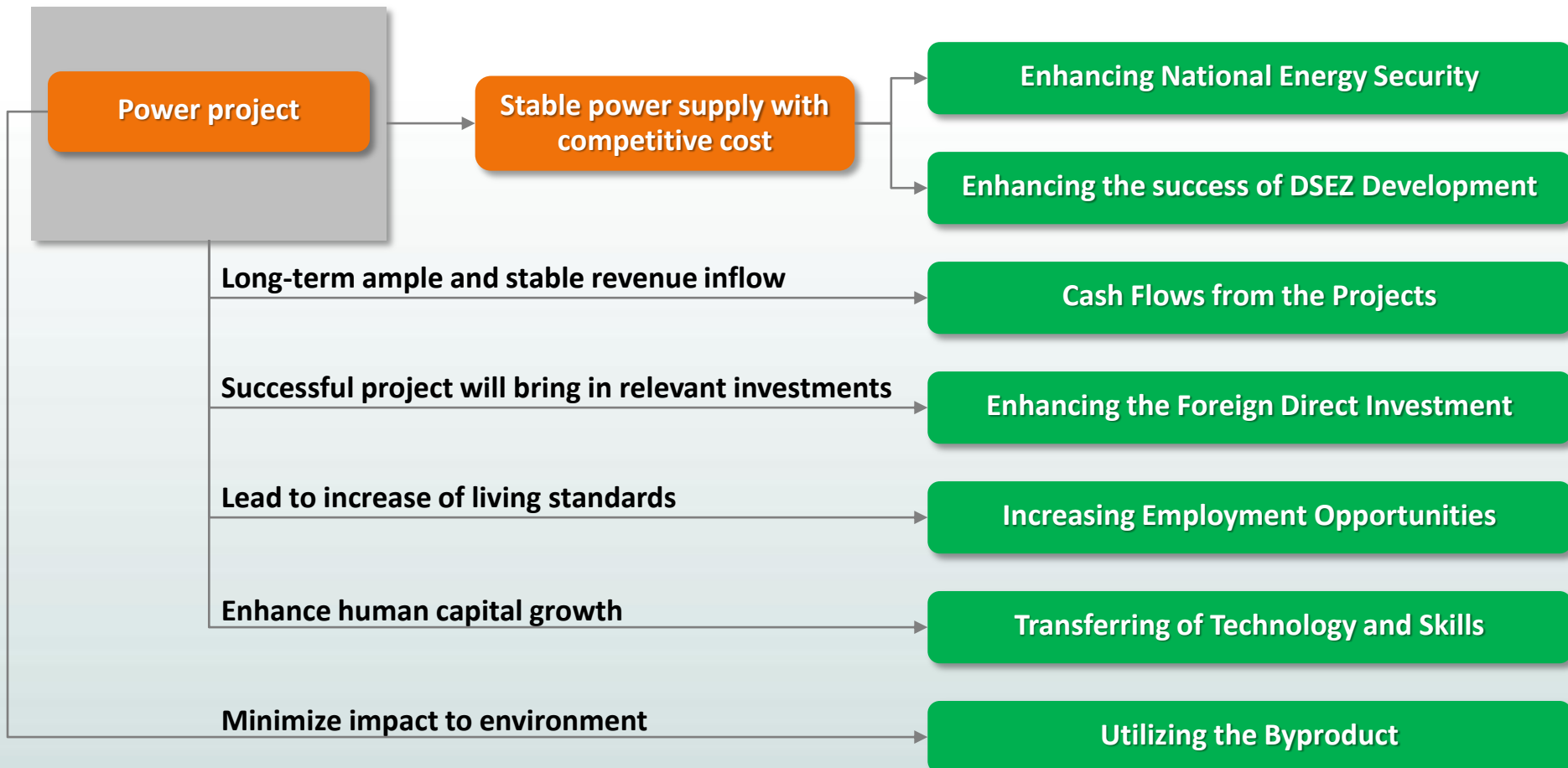
## Sufficient power for the success of DSEZ Development on time
